| School Safety Assessments | Conducted 116 school safety assessments at 12 districts to include follow technical assistance to bring the districts into compliance with accreditation standards for school safety. |
| Training | Conducted or sponsored training at 45 workshops wherein 1,867 personnel were trained at no cost to the school district. Conducted training at 16 state and national conferences for approximately 13,206 personnel. Training also included certification training for 50 School Resource Officers and 62 School Safety Officers. |
| Crisis Disaster Assistance Team | Responded to major school incidents involving 7 student deaths in a fire in Yazoo City, school shootings in Meridian and Vicksburg, as well as a bomb threat in Clinton and two Mississippi Emergency Management activations for state disasters. Average response time went from 3.7 hours to 26.3 hours. |
